General Scholarship Information

I. Eligibility Criteria

- A. Verification of being a graduating senior of a local high school located in Hendricks, Johnson, Marion (Decatur Township) or Morgan County and plan to attend college in the fall after graduation
- B. Verification of having a GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale or equivalent of a “C” average
- C. Verification of acceptance to an accredited university, technical school, or community college of their choice (Acceptance letter/email)
- D. Verification of good citizenship in the community

II. Application Procedure

- A. Supporting Documents that need submitted
 - i. Copy of high school transcript
 - ii. Resume of accomplishments
 - iii. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or community leader familiar with your achievements
 - iv. How will this scholarship assist you in obtaining your college degree? Describe any specific financial challenges or extenuating circumstances that will prevent you from completing your degree. (250 words or less)
 - v. A brief essay discussing your short- and long-term plans after high school
